Directions to Evora from Lisbon Airport

Once leaving the airport, you will find yourself precisely in front of the Airport metro station. Tickets can be bought at a Kiosk outside the airport or inside the metro station. Remember to keep the ticket with you to exit the metro.



Bus Schedules:


There are a handful buses every day, from 8am to 8pm departing from Lisbon *Sete Rios* station. Tickets can be bought <u>online</u> with about a week before departure or at the station. In the opposite direction, from Evora to Lisbon, buses depart from 6am to 9pm.


Train Schedules:


There are 4 trains every day from Lisbon to Evora and the other way around. A detailed schedule can be found here. Trains from Lisbon to Evora depart from *Oriente* station from 7am to 7pm (7:02pm, 9:02pm, 5:02pm and 7:02pm). Tickets can be bought <a href="https://example.com/oriente/example.com/here/examp

Once in Evora, you can find your way to the Venue (Colégio Espirito Santo) by foot – it is not far and Evora is a small town. 

Google Maps R. do Cardeal Rei




